



# BEFORE YOU REGISTER

- Identify a Coach or Team Manager who will be the main point of contact with the league. Ideally, this person will register the team for the season. The individual who registers a team for the season will have access to the team's financials.
- Ensure your team meets the roster requirements for CUSA. A minimum of 12 players must be registered by the date of your first game and must be maintained throughout the season. The maximum is 25 players on the roster, with a max of 20 at a game. 2 males and 2 females must be on the field at all times.
- Each team must have 2 sets of numbered jerseys. In the event of a conflict, the home team must change. Pinnies are allowed if the jersey number is clearly visible underneath.
- Be prepared to play 7 days a week in the Winter. Summer is Mon-Fri for indoor, and Fri/Sun for outdoor. Scheduling requests can be made when registering the team. All teams will have both weekend and weekdays games.
- Home Team's must supply two game balls



# AFTER YOU REGISTER



- Monitor your emails. CUSA will send important league and tournament information as well as fee deadline reminders leading up to the start of the season, and throughout.
  - All players must have a valid ID card at each game. The ID card must state the current team that a player is registered with.
  - Have a team representative attend the Managers Meeting at the start of every season. League schedules are available for the first time at this meeting, and important league and rule updates are provided.
  - Every team must send a representative to the Annual General Meeting in June of every year. Adequate notice will be sent to all team officials. This is the only mandatory meeting that membership must attend.
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
